Mr. Nellis is a former president of the Association of Erie County Governments, and founder and current member of the South Towns Coalition for Community Enhancement, focusing on improving economic development.

Mr. Nellis is a Vietnam veteran, having served in the United States Air Force as a member of the Strategic Air Command for the intelligence group, Lucky Dragon, and is a current member of the American Legion, Post 880.

Mr. Nellis is a founder of the Eden Regional Farm Museum and has been a member since 2006 and was named the 2015 Eden Chamber of Commerce Citizen of the Year for his unprecedented dedication to improving the community.
